

SANE Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners

Central Valley has trained Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners that provide immediate and follow up medical care including forensic medical exams, treatment for sexually transmitted diseases, pregnancy options, counseling and referrals.

SANEs are part of a team of professionals from the community known as the Sexual Assault Response Team (SART). SART is a multi-disciplinary approach that coordinates medical, advocacy and criminal justice services to victims of sexual assault.

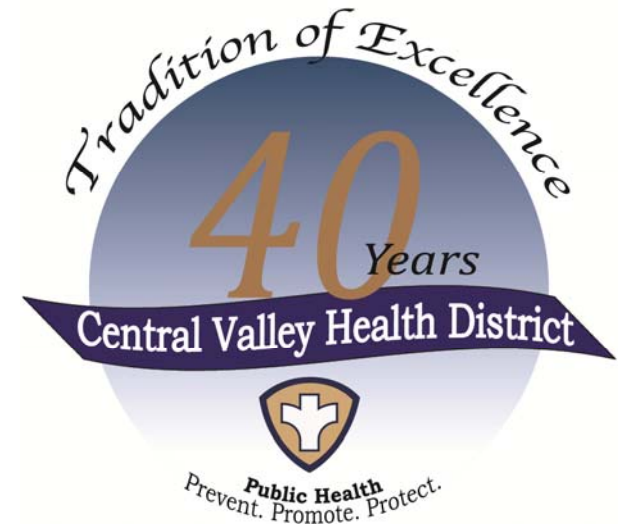

Women's Way

Women's Way is a breast and cervical cancer early detection program available to North Dakota women. Funding is available for mammograms, clinical breast exams, pap smears and pelvic exams. To see if you qualify call 252-8130 or 800-449-6636.

WIC

Women/ Infants/ Children

WIC is a special supplement food program for pregnant or breastfeeding women, infants and children under 5 years of age. Must meet income guidelines, and be screened for a nutritional risk. Clients receive an individualized food package and nutrition education.

Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR)

The EPR Division focuses on planning, training, and conducting exercises for all public health related emergencies such as bioterrorism, pandemic flu, and natural disasters. Educational materials on preparing for emergencies at home and at work are also provided.

Environmental Health

The Environmental Health Division is responsible for health and safety inspections to enforce state public health laws, CVHD regulations, and pertinent local ordinances. Environmental health education is also provided as needed.
